This was to provide consistently good to outstanding teaching and learning in Physical Education for all age phases (inc. SEND) Furthermore, as part of their role the number of playtime, lunchtime and after-school clubs would increase to improve physical activity and physical education.	From termly lesson observations and performance management, both Sports Leads will have been judged good or outstanding consistently.
