Reading and Spelling

Please make sure you send your child's book bag into school everyday with their reading book and reading record. It is very important that children read regularly at home to develop their understanding and fluency. A reader of the week is chosen every week to reward children who are reading on a nightly basis at home. Please make sure you sign your child's reading record when they read.

Every Friday your child will be given weekly spellings. They will need to practise them each night ready for a spelling test every Thursday.
