UPDATE: SCHOOL BUILDING AND PUPIL PROVISION

Dear Parents / Carers

Firstly, we would like to thank those of you who have shown such support to the academy since the fire incident on Thursday. It has been an incredibly busy few days in order to ensure your children's education continues and your appreciation of this is greatly received. Thank you.

Like so many of you have shared with us this morning, we are also very disappointed that some parents have chosen to be so negative on social media about the communication and planned provision. With no access to the academy, or its systems, we have done our very best to keep you as informed as possible and are saddened that this has not been recognised by some.

We hope that the information below clarifies the position for this week, as well as other queries that have been raised:

- Children should continue to arrive at Pennyman throughout this week, as shared with you via both text and on the academy website.
- There will be no Breakfast Club or After School Clubs this week.
- The photograph days which were planned for Tuesday 4th and Wednesday 5th April have been cancelled. They will be rearranged for the summer term.
- Open Afternoon will not take place on Friday 7th April. Children should be collected at 3pm as normal.
- As we cannot currently be definite of a completion date for the works, there will be no holiday clubs over Easter. We will put more opportunities on over May Half Term and the Summer.
- The academy should re- open as normal on Monday 24th April 2017.
- Year 6 children will complete their SAT's in May at Pennyman, in their normal classrooms.

May we again thank you for your support and we shall update you further by letter throughout this week. All information will also be added to the academy website.
